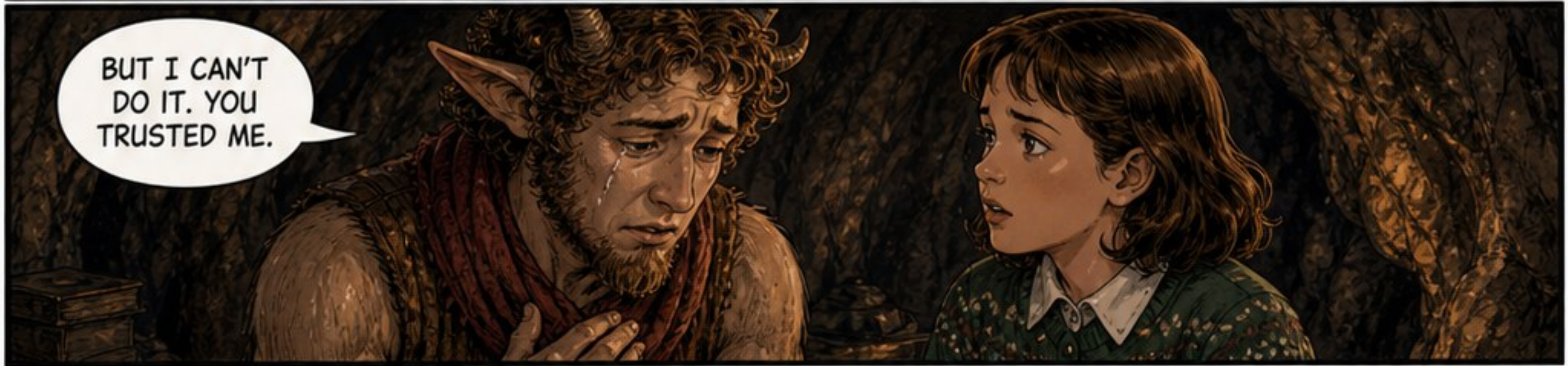

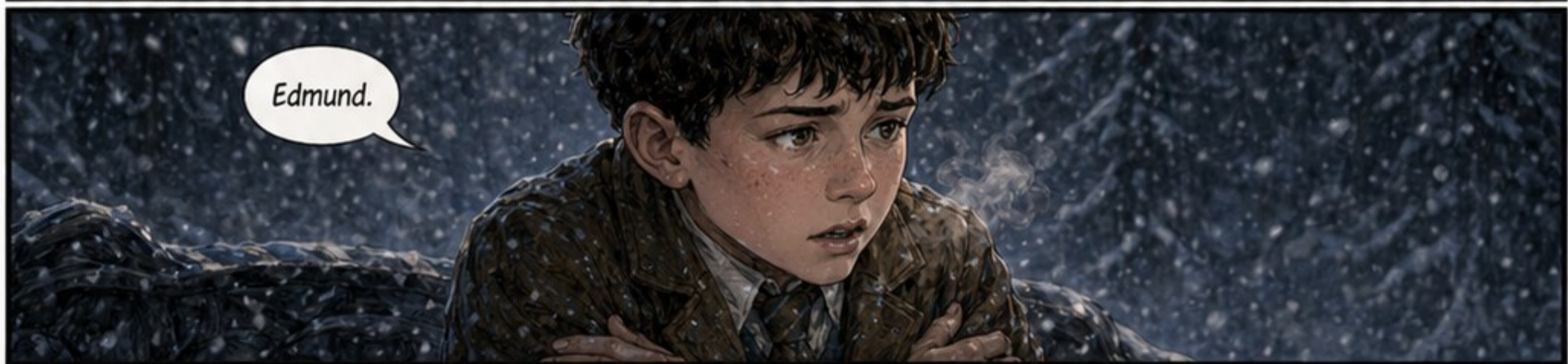
I'M... I'M A BOY.

COME AND SIT BESIDE ME. I WILL NOT BITE YOU.





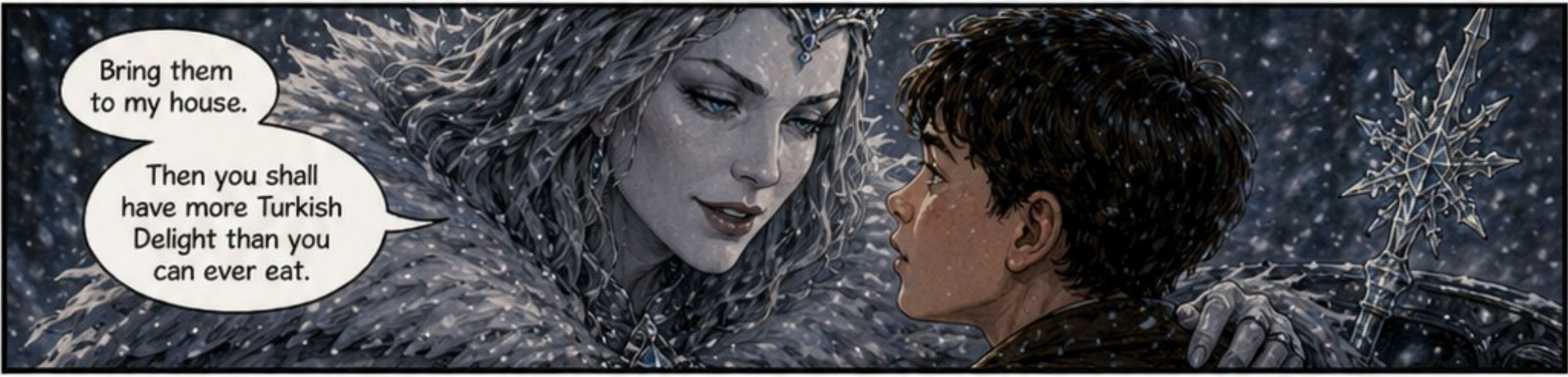
Eat, dear Edmund.

And is she usually sane?



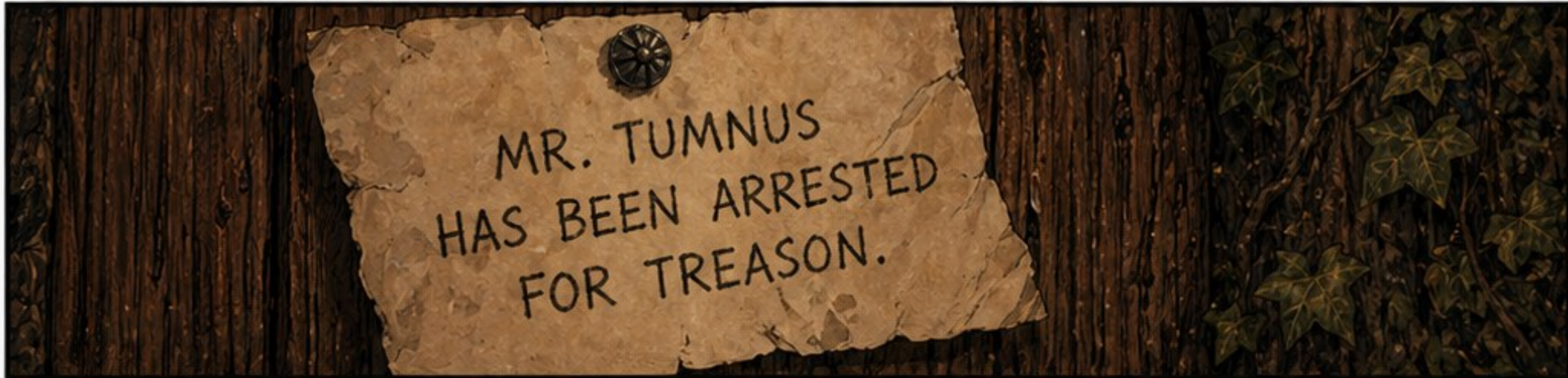
Of course she is.

And with it, her certainty.



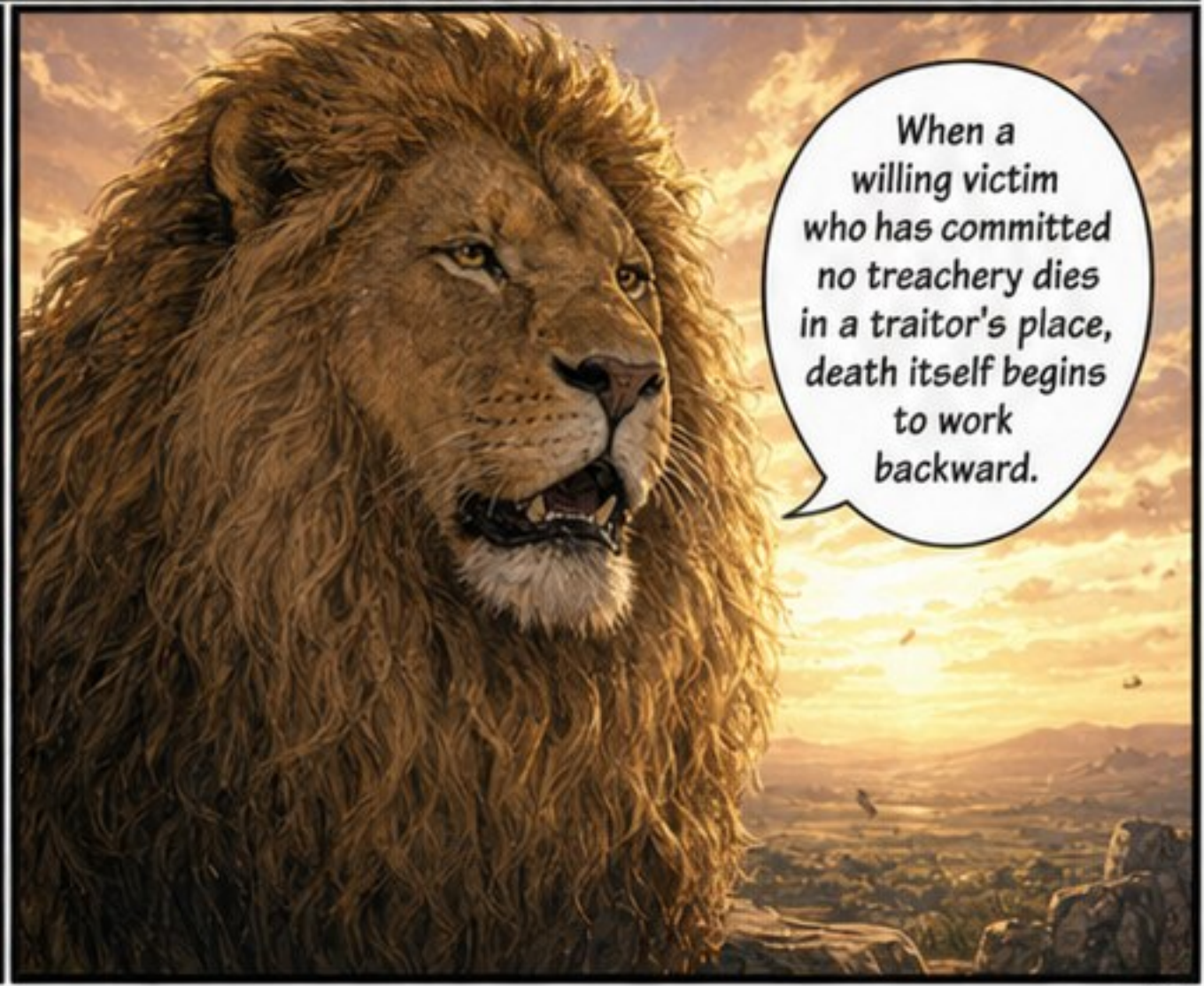
